

## **SUPPLEMENTAL TOURNAMENT RULES FOR 2021 DUE TO COVID**

### **Revised 6-14-21**

It is the responsibility of the manager to see to it that all Rules and Regulations (including COVID policies) are being followed. Every manager needs to make sure that each player has no signs or symptoms of COVID, nor been exposed to someone who has COVID before attending any game. If anyone is sick or has a fever (temperature of 100.4 or above), they should remain home. Each team is responsible for taking the temperature of everyone on the team (including coaches) at the start of the day. If they have a fever over 100.4 degrees, they may not attend. Coaches are to maintain a temperature log throughout the tournament.

Covid waivers must be signed by all participants that are on the bench, this includes but is not limited, to players, parents and coaching staff, and submitted to us by the Manager no later than June 18th. If a player is added to the Roster after June 18th, then the waiver must be provided to us when the player is added.

**As it pertains to OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES and consistent with Governor Hogan's Executive Order, masks are no longer required by participants, coaches, officials, or spectators. However, Baltimore County Recreation and Parks is providing the following guidance about when masking is recommended and strongly recommended:**

- 1. Masks are recommended, but not required, for participants not engaged in play, coaches, officials, and all other spectators.**
- 2. Masks are strongly recommended, but not required, when social distancing is not possible among spectators.**
- 3. Masks are strongly recommended, but not required, for anyone who is not fully vaccinated and not directly engaged in play, regardless of whether social distancing is possible.**

### **BATHROOM FACILITIES**

If you have not been vaccinated for Covid, please wear a face mask while in County Government buildings and/or restrooms.

### **TEAMS ENTERING/EXITING FIELDS**

A team cannot enter the field until the prior teams have exited the field and surrounding area. Those exiting the fields, please do so as quickly as possible so that the next team can get onto the field and games can get started promptly. If you have to wait for your next game, please do so in an open area away from the field and practice social distancing until it is your turn to take the field again.

No congregating behind back stops or other areas near the game site.

## UMPIRES

Umpires are not required to wear masks, although recommended.

Each team will designate **ONE person** to talk with the Umpire. This person will be the same one throughout the whole game. Please please keep your team and parents under control. We do not want any ejections or other controversy.
